7. Why do you push yourself outside your comfort zone this year in outdoor ed. and what did you learn?

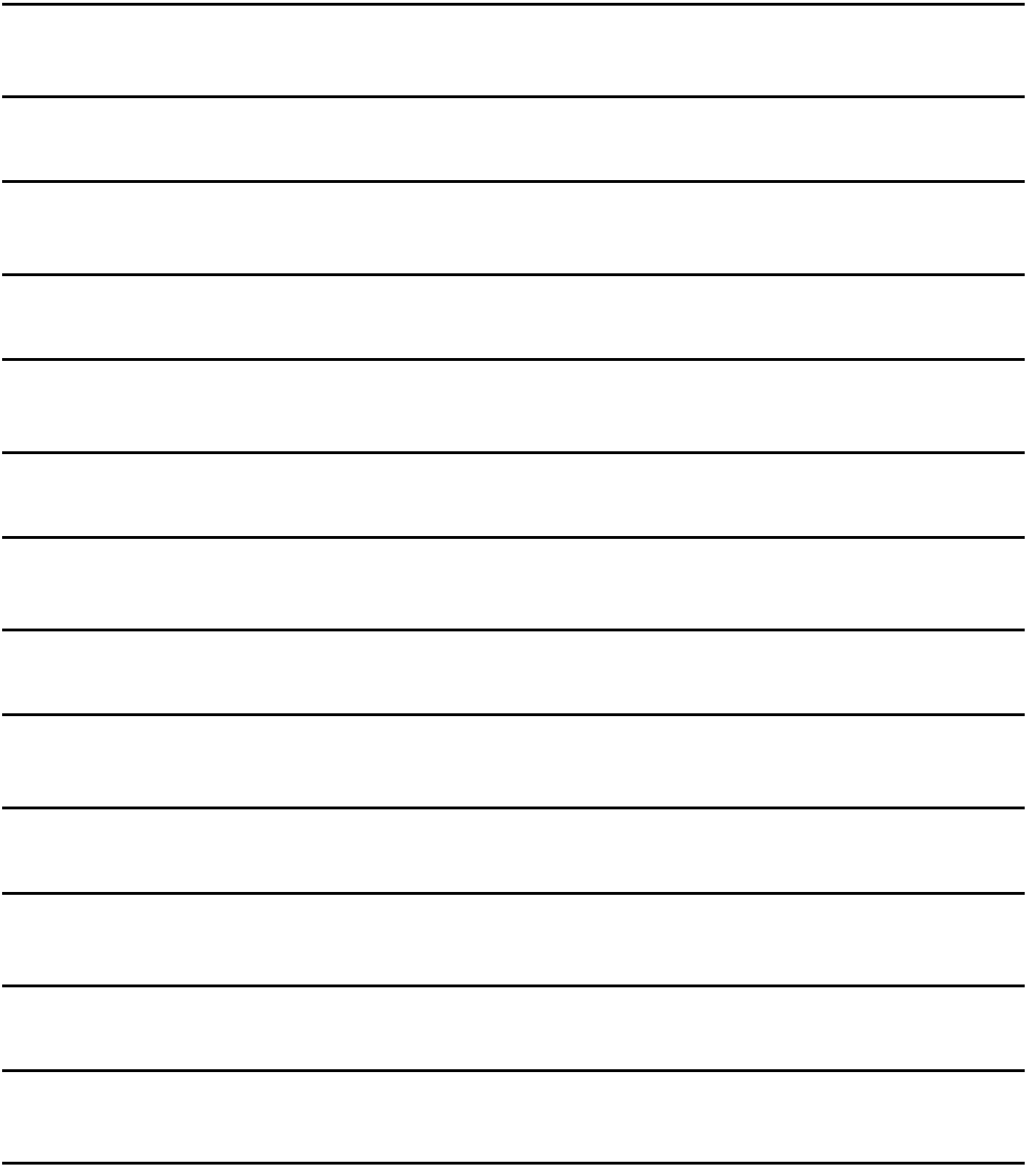
