Part A

The six elements and their definitions are:

- 1. Caring for others** - is really the act of going out of your way to help or prevent physical, spiritual, or emotional hurts or pains of another.
- 2. Trust** - Trust means that you rely on someone else to do the right thing. You believe in the person's integrity and strength, to the extent that you're able to put yourself on the line, at some risk to yourself. Trust is essential to an effective team, because it provides a sense of safety.
- 3. An appreciation of others** - the quality of being thankful; readiness to show appreciation for and to return kindness.
- 4. Being responsible or committed** - A duty or obligation to satisfactorily perform or complete a task (assigned by someone, or created by one's own promise or circumstances) that one must fulfill, and which has a consequent penalty for failure.
- 5. Being Selfless** - Being selfless starts with having the ability to see beyond your personal concerns and empathize with others, even those you've never met. If you understand how someone else feels, you'll be more likely to be moved to act selflessly toward that person.
- 6. Moral behavior, integrity and character** -standing up for what's right; conscientiousness; and responsibility for oneself and the less fortunate.

For each of the 6 elements use the following criteria to complete Part A.

- A.** Title of the element you are describing in your paragraph (Trust, Caring for others, An appreciation of Learning, Being responsible or committed, Being Selfless)
- B.** Picture from my Facebook or that you have, that were taken during the course that represents the element that you are describing.
- C.** Description of the snap shot or another experience that you had in outdoor ed. where you carried out each of the elements listed above, be very specific and detailed **(2-3+ sentences)**
- D.** How did you carrying out this element improve the group or class as a whole, be specific **(1-2+ sentences)**
- E.** How will you as a person improve your character if you recruit these elements and include them in your everyday life **(2-3+ sentences)**
